Orphanage Renovations Church Planting Education Help Needed



We have been blessed with a busy summer, full of wonderful teams who came to share the gospel of Jesus with the children and the community surrounding the orphanage and to do some much needed renovations to the orphanage. New windows were installed (no more cardboard windows!) and the electrical system was updated. In addition, the perimeter wall was made taller and barbed wire was installed on the walls surrounding the compound. Fire safety/drill training was conducted including the purchase of safety equipment such as fire extinguishers. And we had an awesome Vacation Bible School. God has been GREAT to us! Our next projects will include updating the plumbing and floor tiles.

October 2019

We have three active church plantings, Hallelujah! The church in Lavelle is currently building; it has a roof. Pastor Shirley's church from CT has agreed to sponsor this church, praise the Lord! We have purchased the land where the church is being built. Our goal is to purchase a second piece of land adjacent to the church land and build a school. We are excited to see what God has planned!

A missionary team from Washington, DC is sponsoring the second church plant and have invested the money to start the foundation. Blessings upon blessings we are receiving! The third church plant is in the mountains with about 250 people, 18 of which have asked to be baptized! There is no building yet and we are looking for a group to sponsor this project. We thank God and are excited about what God is doing with this ministry!

We are currently in dire need of persons to help send the children to school and provide them with uniforms. Private school expenses have not been covered for several of the children. We are in need of \$13,000 to cover all expenses for the year to cover school supplies (notebooks, books, pencils, pens, etc.), uniforms, tuition, backpacks, shoes, lunch boxes, undergarments, tutors and tutorial supplies.
